Do you believe in God? – Back to religion – The struggle for the young – Shiva, Jesus and Maria

**01.07** Shiva, Jesus and Maria: Raji, 14 years old, lives in a multicultural world which has many gods.

**01.16** The struggle for the young: churches and religious groups try to attract young members with trendy ideas.

**02.21** Damaris Sanchez is a 20 year-old Roman Catholic: she is about to sit her final exams. For eight years she's been an altar server in the Liebfrauenkirche in Zurich for eight years.

**06.13** It's Friday evening; Hüseyin is going to the mosque in Baar, which is located in a factory building. As a Muslim he is confronted by many prejudices. What does he think about Islam and violence?

**10.31** Back to the 17th century, to the time of the Enlightenment. A wave of secularisation began in Europe at that time. The authority of the church was called into question. One of the most famous figures of the Enlightenment was the French writer Voltaire.

**15.25** Hip and trendy – a so-called celebration in the Zürich Maag-Areal, organised by the International Christian Fellowship, icf for short. Their leader and senior pastor is Leo Bigger.

**19.13** Stauffacherplatz in Zürich, the protestant St. Jakob Church. This is home to a second youth project of the official national church. It's called Streetchurch. It's not only the church building that has been converted, the church service has too.

**24.09** This mixture of various religions is no problem at all for Raji – above the house altar hangs a poster showing Jesus Christ in peaceful coexistence with the Hindu elephant god Ganesha and the great mosque at Mecca.

Out of all these gods and saints Raji loves one Hindu goddess in particular.
