

## Late Night Jazz – A Great Day in Harlem

Samstag, 10. November 2018 22.05 – 24.00 SRF 2 Kultur

Vor sechzig Jahren, im Sommer 1959, fanden sich vor einem Haus an der 126. Strasse in Harlem, New York 57 Jazzmusiker, darunter drei Frauen ein. Der Esquire-Fotograf Art Kane hatte sie hergebeten, um ein Gruppenbild zu einer Titelgeschichte über das goldene Zeitalter des Jazz zu machen. Tatsächlich: Wer das Foto anschaut, sieht den Titel des Artikels bestätigt, fast die ganze Prominenz der damaligen Jazzwelt ist versammelt, von A wie Henry «Red» Allen bis Y wie Lester Young. 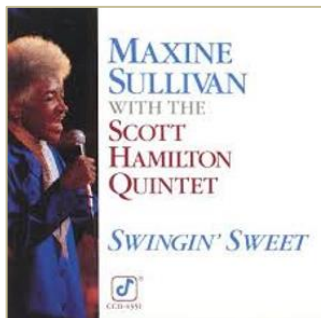

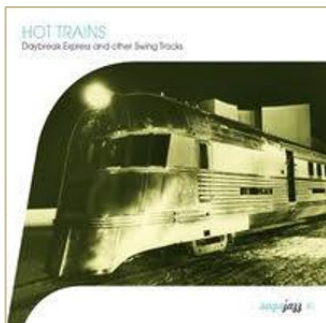

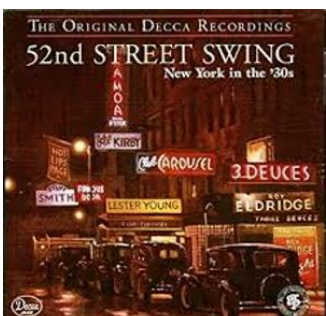

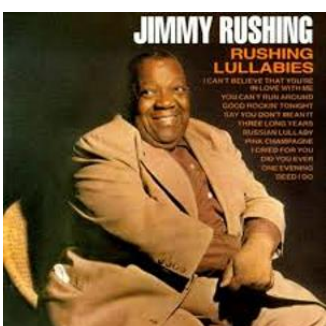

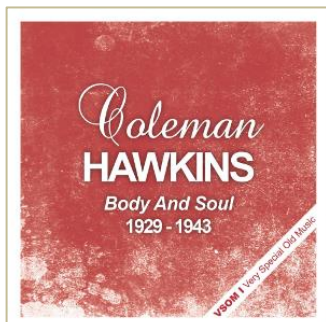

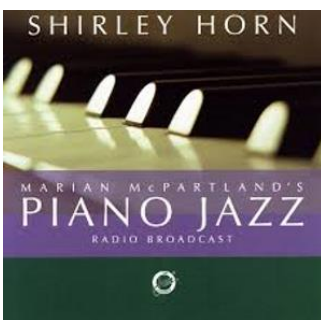

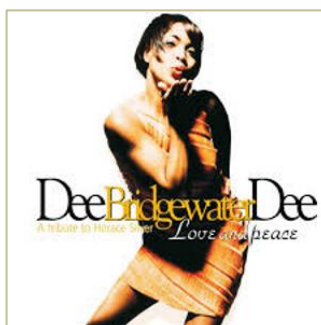
